



FEDERAL ENERGY TAX CREDIT

Great Lakes Seabrooke replacement windows meet or exceed federal energy tax credit requirements of a U-Factor rating of .30 or lower and a Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) rating of .30 or lower.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR HOMEOWNERS

- Up to \$1,500 maximum credit for windows for all taxable years.
- Allowed only for amounts paid or incurred to purchase the window or door.
- Not allowed for amounts paid for onsite preparation, assembly, original installation labor, other components or sales tax.
- This credit is valid on products purchased and installed between January 1, 2009, and December 31, 2010.
- The purchase must be made during the taxable year for which the credit is claimed.
